Dear Parent/Guardian,

I would like to welcome the pupils back after their Easter break to our final term in primary one.

During term 3 the pupils visited the Glenlee and Udston woods where they worked with the woodland rangers. During these visits the pupils learned about woodland animals and animal habitats.

Topic

This term starts with the pupils learning about Welcoming a Baby into their home, they will be learning what is needed to keep a baby healthy and safe. They have already been sharing their great ideas and knowledge with their peers. They work together in the role play area helping to change nappies, make a bottle and bath the doll. Our final topic in primary one will focus on Commonwealth Games.



Language

The pupils continue to develop their reading skills learning to become confident in using their sounds to read and make words. They are developing the correct formation of letters during handwriting lessons and this is reinforced within all writing aspects in class. During writing lessons the pupils will be developing skills in using joining words within a sentence and are encouraged to write more than one sentence using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

Maths

Within maths the pupils have gained a good understanding of the concept of addition and challenge themselves by adding high numbers together. They have been learning about time and sequencing activities throughout the day. They have been learning about o'clock and can recognise this on analogue and digital clocks. During this term they will be introduced to the concept of subtraction.



PE
